

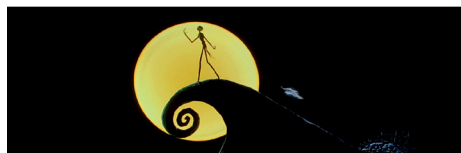
TOP 10: HALLOWEEN MOVIES

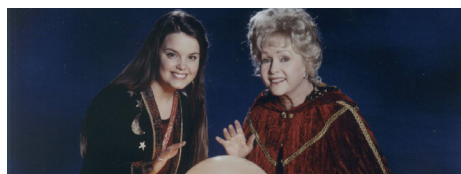
THE NIGHTMARE BEFORE CHRISTMAS

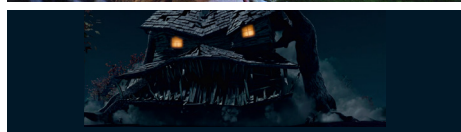
TWITCHES TOO
