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*To become a zombie, you're going to need a couple of things.*

## LIQUID LATEX

- If you're allergic to latex or just don't have it on hand, you can use white glue or corn syrup and flour as an alternative.

## TISSUE

- Regular tissue or toilet paper will work. This is needed to place on the liquid latex to provide texture on your face, creating skin.

## FOUNDATION

- You'll need this to cover the latex or whatever you used, so that it'll look like actual skin.

## FAKE BLOOD

- To make your wounds look realistic and gooey.

## SCAR PUTTY

- This can help create the effect of rotting skin.

## BRUISE MAKEUP

- This will help add depth and texture to your wounds so that you'll look like a real decaying zombie!

Before applying these things, there's a few things you need to know:

- Make sure that if you do use the latex, the area does NOT have any hair or dryness on it whatsoever.
- If you absolutely have to apply it near or on your eyebrows, make sure they are covered!
- Do NOT apply the latex with your fingers, use a brush or a sponge. Basically, anything that is not your fingers.
- Also try to avoid your eye area, yes you can put makeup around it, but make sure that you don't get too close!

*Now with that said, you are ready to become a zombie! The look is completely up to you! You can add more, add less, it all depends on the type of zombie that you want to be.*
